additional conversation is happening with the Wiyot Tribe about sites they would like to have represented on the map. There will be ongoing opportunities for mapping. More cultural assets will be identified as more people participate. Vahan will circulate information to the group to share feedback.

Vahan shared about the experience of presenting at the California Main Street conference The website is in the works.

Vahan is looking for a doodle artist.

More photos are needed. Vahan is also working with a photographer. Community engagement is taking place.

Vahan is working on a group that is creating a regional cultural festival, partially funded by County TOT funding.

Parts of the AIDS memorial guilt will be coming to our community.
